• EXTENSIVE USE OF TECHNOLOGY FOR BETTER CLARITY OF THE CONCEPTS



• WORKSHOPS FOR TEACHERS


To keep the teachers abreast of the latest in the teaching world, various workshops are conducted time to time. They are also given an opportunity to be part of FDRC


, CBSE workshops.
