2. <u>Vidyanjali – Community Welfare Programmes:</u>

This is an initiative taken by the Ministry of Education, Government of India with the aim to strengthen Schools through community and private sector involvement in schools across the country. This initiative intends to connect schools with voluntary contribution from officials, teachers and bring significance change in the education system through mutual exchange of ideas and initiative. Under the Scheme Army Public School has adopted Govt Secondary School SI Lines, Bhopal with the aim of strengthening the infrastructure, facilities and improving the quality of education in Govt and Govt aided schools.

3. <u>Classrooms equipped with Interactive LED Panels:</u>

The school has recently introduced Interactive LED Panels in Classes IX to XII and is in process of introducing the same across all other classrooms in the coming months. These panels are fully interactive computer system with dedicated modules of all the subjects of each class and has special features like screen record, whiteboard, casting etc. Content integrated in these systems is mapped according to the Board and textbooks prescribed by the NCERT, which are contextual subject-specific tools, to support teachers, such as Diagram Maker, timelines, practicals etc.

7. <u>Experiential Learning:</u>

8. <u>Career Counselling:</u>

9. <u>School Committees:</u>

The School has a fully functional, vigilant and effective monitoring system ensuring safety and well-being of both its students as well as teachers and thereby important Committees have been formed, namely:

APS Bhopal has an internal POCSO complaints committee to register a complaint from either a parent or a student and thereby follow the procedure of reporting to Special Juvenile Police Unit (SJPU).

<u>PoSH (Prevention of Sexual Harassment) Internal Complaints</u> <u>Committee 2023-24</u>:

The committee aims to protect female employees from sexual harassment in the workplace. This committee addresses, resolves, decide on appropriate punitive actions or reports to the Police for further action on the behest of the complainant.
